Summer camp is a great opportunity for parents and children to get out of the habit of constant contact and, especially for parents, constant reassurance that their kids are okay."



Does this sound familiar?!?! Our high number of staff who were former campers AND our commitment to refrain from posting daily photos are two very special aspects of Schodack. They are fundamental parts of our philosophy of what is best for kids. I thought it would be fun to share this quote so we can all feel proud of the community we are creating for children at Schodack.




